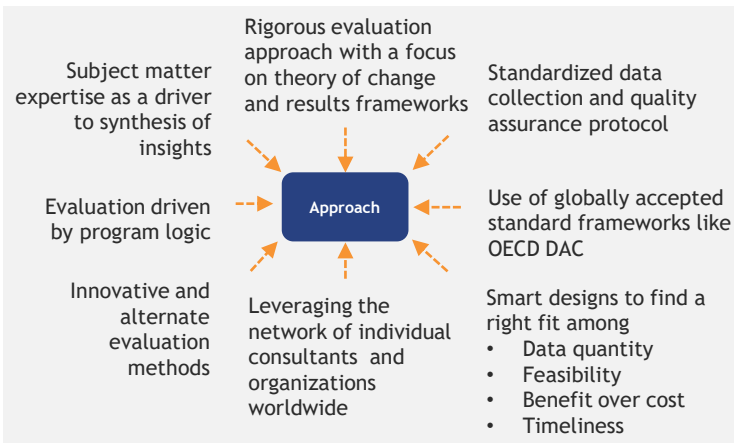


Monitoring and impact assessment

The challenge

- M&E is still considered to be a compliance requirement in the social sector. Organizations need to value it as a core strategic pillar.
- Projects and programs still lack actionable insights that can feed directly into program strategy.
- Monitoring at the level of outcomes is not practiced widely yet
